**Authority to Authorize Testimony and the Production of Records**

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, 5 U.S.C. §§ 401-424; Treasury Order 115-01; Department of the Treasury General Counsel Order No. 5; and Treasury Department Regulation 31 C.F.R. § 1.11.

Attorneys within the Office of Chief Counsel are delegated the authority to authorize Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) employees to testify or produce records pursuant to a request or demand for the disclosure of such records or information in administrative or judicial proceedings.

All persons authorizing testimony or the production of TIGTA records pursuant to this Chief Counsel Delegation Order shall ensure compliance with applicable statutes, regulations, orders, and the TIGTA Operations Manual.

The authority delegated under this Chief Counsel Delegation Order may not be re-delegated.
