AUTHORITY TO APPROVE REPRESENTATION
FUND EXPENSES

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended, 5 U.S.C. §§ 401-424, the Internal Revenue Service Restructuring and Reform Act of 1998, Pub. L. No. 105-206, 112 Stat. 685; and Treasury Order 115-01.

Authority to approve payments for representation fund expenditures is delegated as follows:

The Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and the Director for Finance and Procurement Services/Deputy CFO may authorize all representation fund expenditures.

This authority may not be re-delegated.
