Acting Inspector General



Heather M. Hill is the Acting Inspector General for Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA). In this role, Ms. Hill is TIGTA's highest-ranking career official and provides executive leadership and strategic vision to advance TIGTA's oversight of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). She leads a nationwide workforce of approximately 700 auditors, evaluators, investigators, data analysts, attorneys, and management and support professionals to achieve TIGTA's mission and goals.

Ms. Hill joined TIGTA in 2011 and previously served as its Deputy Inspector General for Audit, overseeing independent audits of the IRS and issuing recommendations to improve federal tax administration. Earlier roles at TIGTA included Deputy Inspector General for Inspections and Evaluations, Assistant Inspector General for Audit, Management Services and Exempt Organizations, and as the Director, Special Tax Matters for TIGTA's Office of Inspections and Evaluations.

Prior to joining TIGTA, Ms. Hill was an analyst at the Government Accountability Office, where she worked on a range of energy and agricultural issues as part of the Natural Resources and Environment team. She also led investigations into fraud and abuse of Government programs as part of the Forensic Audits and Special Investigations team.

Ms. Hill graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with a Bachelor of Arts in Government and a Master of Public Affairs from the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs. Ms. Hill also has a Master of Science in Social Science Research Methods from the University of Cardiff, Wales.
