FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT AND PRIVACY ACT REQUESTS

Authority: Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a, 31 C.F.R. § 1.1 et seq., Treasury Order No. 115-01.

1. The Chief Counsel to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration is hereby delegated the authority to make initial agency determinations with regard to Freedom of Information and Privacy Act requests for access to or amendment of TIGTA records. This authority may be re-delegated.
2. The Chief Counsel to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration is hereby delegated the authority to make final agency determinations with regard to administrative appeals under the Freedom of Information and Privacy Acts. This authority may be re-delegated to the Deputy Chief Counsel.
