**DELEGATION OF PROCUREMENT AUTHORITY, PURCHASE CARD  
PROGRAM**

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended (5 U.S.C. app. 3); the Economy Act of 1932, as amended (31 U.S.C. § 1535); Federal Acquisition Regulation (Title 48 of the Code of Federal Regulations); Treasury Order 115-01; Treasury Directive 12-11; and Treasury Order 101-30.

1. The Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer (CFO) is delegated authority to issue written delegations of procurement authority not to exceed the micro-purchase threshold, as defined in section 2.101 of the Federal Acquisition Regulations, to TIGTA purchase cardholders.
2. This authority may be re-delegated to the Assistant Director, Finance and Procurement Services/Deputy CFO.
