Authority to Disclose Identity

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended (5 U.S.C. App. 3), the Internal Revenue Service Restructuring and Reform Act of 1998 (Pub. L. No. 105-206), and Treasury Order 115-01.

The following positions are delegated the authority to disclose the identity of an employee who is entitled to confidentiality pursuant to the Inspector General Act of 1978 when it is determined that such a disclosure is unavoidable during the course of an investigation:

Deputy Inspector General for Investigations
Chief Counsel to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration
Assistant Inspectors General for Investigations
Deputy Assistant Inspectors General for Investigations
Special Agents-in-Charge, Office of Investigations

This authority may not be redelegated.

The following positions are delegated the authority to disclose the identity of an employee who is entitled to confidentiality pursuant to the IG Act when it is determined that such a disclosure is unavoidable during the course of an investigation and when the disclosure is made to the Department of Justice:

Assistant Special Agents-in-Charge or higher

This authority may not be redelegated.
