**AUTHORITY TO REVIEW CONFIDENTIAL FILER STATUS**

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, 5 U.S.C. app. 3 (as amended); Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 5 U.S.C. app. (as amended); Executive Order No. 12,674, 54 Fed. Reg. 15159 (Apr. 14, 1989), *modified*, Executive Order No. 12,731, 55 Fed. Reg. 42547 (Oct. 19, 1990); Executive Branch Financial Disclosure, Qualified Trusts, and Certificates of Divestiture 5 C.F.R. Part 2634; Supplemental Standards of Ethical Conduct for Employees of the Department of the Treasury, 5 C.F.R. Part 3101; Treasury Order 107-01; and Treasury Directive 61-02.

TIGTA's Chief Counsel is the Deputy Ethics Officer (DEO). The DEO is delegated authority to review and issue a final and conclusive decision on any complaint filed by an individual alleging that his or her position has been improperly determined by the agency to be one which requires the submission of a confidential financial report pursuant to 5 C.F.R. § 2634.906. The Chief Counsel may re-delegate this authority to the Deputy Chief Counsel.
