**DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO APPROVE MEMORANDA
OF UNDERSTANDING AND INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS**

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended (5 U.S.C. app. (2018)); the Economy Act of 1932, as amended (31 U.S.C. § 1535); Federal Acquisition Regulation (Title 48 of the Code of Federal Regulations), and Treasury Order 115-01.

The Principal Deputy Inspector General, Deputy Inspectors General, Chief Counsel and Chief Information Officer are delegated authority to sign Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) and Interagency Agreements (IAA) setting forth General Terms and Conditions, including statutory authorities and scope of work, related to the services that will be provided or received from a Federal, State, or local government agency. The delegated individuals shall give notice of the MOUs and IAAs to the Inspector General.

The Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer is delegated authority to sign all Memoranda of Understanding and Interagency Agreements as the funding official.

These authorities may be re-delegated.
