MISSION SUPPORT DELEGATION ORDER NO. 1 (Rev. 3)  
EFFECTIVE DATE: October 22, 2024

**Order of Succession and Designation to Act**

**Authority:** Inspector General Act of 1978, 5 U.S.C. §§ 401-424; Internal Revenue Service Restructuring and Reform Act of 1998, Pub. L. No. 105-206; 112 Stat. 685-868; Treasury Order 115-01; and TIGTA Delegation Order No. 28.

**Purpose:** To provide an order of succession for the Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer for the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration, in the event that the Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer is temporarily or permanently unable to perform the functions and duties of the position by reason of absence, disability, vacancy, or other causes.

1. Vacancy.

In cases where there is a vacancy in the position of Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer or the incumbent is unavailable to perform the functions and duties of the position in the foreseeable future, *e.g.*, by reason of death, resignation, termination, imprisonment, or debilitating illness, the individual occupying the following positions will, in the order stated, assume said duties:

- Assistant Inspector General for Mission Support
- Director, Finance and Procurement Services/Deputy Chief Financial Officer
- Director, Human Capital and Personnel Security/Human Capital Officer
- Director, Facilities Management and Support Services

Persons acting for a designated Successor are excluded from the chain of succession.

2. Absence.

Notwithstanding paragraph 1, in cases where the Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer is absent, sick, or otherwise temporarily unavailable to perform their duties, they may designate an employee of the Office of Mission Support to act as Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer and perform the functions and duties of the Deputy Inspector General for Mission

Support/Chief Financial Officer. In those cases, in which the Deputy Inspector General for Mission Support/Chief Financial Officer is unable to designate an official prior to the temporary absence, then operational management will devolve upon the persons and in the order described in paragraph 1.

3.     Redelegation.

The authority delegated under this Mission Support Delegation Order may not be redelegated.
